The Group of Biology of Reproduction is seeking a highly motivated PhD student to join our research team at the Institute of Marine Sciences (ICM-CSIC) by middle of 2017. The aim of the PhD thesis is to identify how environmental changes affect fish gonads at the epigenetic level.

Candidates should hold a Master's degree in Biology, Genetics, Aquaculture or similar with high qualifications in both Degree and Master studies. The PhD position is funded by a one-year contract and continued funding will depend on the competence of the candidate.

The proposed project involves working, among others, with live fish, molecular techniques in the lab and *in silico* analysis by handling bioinformatics data.
